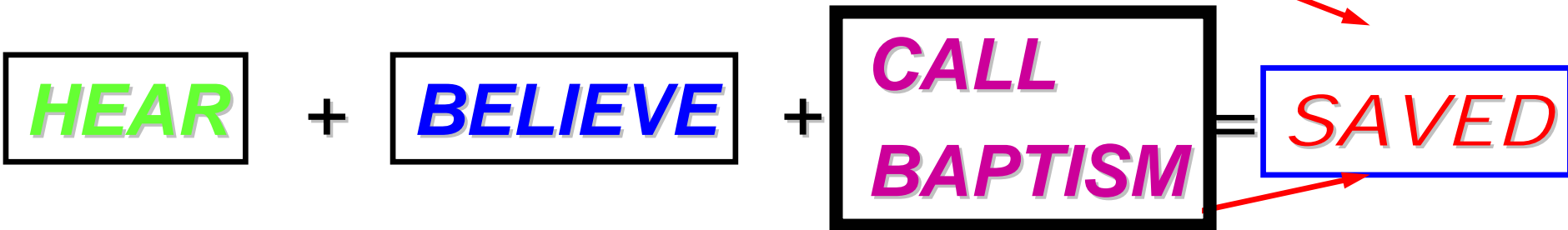
'BELIEVING'
