1. All The Law Of Moses Is Fulfilled  
(Luke 24:44)
2. All The Law of Moses Has Passed Away.
3. The "Ten Commandment" Covenant Is  
Written In The Law Of Moses" (Deut. 5)
4. **THEREFORE THE TEN COMMANDMENT  
COVENANT HAS "PASSED AWAY"**

# MATTHEW 5:17-18

What Jesus Did NOT Say:

- "I am come to perpetuate the Law"
- "As long as heaven and earth remain, every jot and tittle shall stand"

## SABBATARIAN DILEMMA

- Will the ten commandments pass away when heaven and earth pass away?
- If "jot and tittle" mean every part of the law, then they have none of it passing away and should keep all the "ceremonial" aspects of it too!

# MATTHEW 5:17-18

What Jesus Did Say:

". . .till heaven and earth pass away, one jot or one tittle will by no means pass from the law till all is fulfilled" (Matt. 5:18)

## IMPLICATIONS

- none will pass till all be fulfilled
- if any has passed, then all has been fulfilled
- if fulfilled, then even the "jot and tittle" has passed
- if not fulfilled, then Jesus didn't accomplish what he came to do and all of the law (including the jot and tittle) remain!

# "Till" In God's Word



- "And did not know her TILL she had brought forth her firstborn Son" (Matt. 1:25).

**IMPLIES KNEW HER AFTER!**

- "I have a baptism to be baptized with, and how distressed I am TILL it is accomplished" (Lk. 12:50)

**IMPLIES NO DISTRESS AFTER!**

- "And when it was day, some of the Jews banded together and bound themselves under an oath, saying that they would neither eat nor drink TILL they had killed Paul" (Acts 23:12).

**IMPLIES THEY WOULD EAT AND DRINK AFTER!**

# LIKEWISE

"...till heaven and earth pass away, one jot or one tittle will by no means pass from the law till all is fulfilled" (Matt. 5:18)

**IMPLIES WOULD PASS AWAY  
AFTER FULFILLED!**

**(When you leave out "till all is fulfilled" you  
change the Lord's meaning)**
