The Sabbath Taken Away!

Colossians 2:14-16

"having wiped out the handwriting of requirements that was against us, which was contrary to us. And He has taken it out of the way, having nailed it to the cross . . . So let no one judge you in food or in drink, or regarding a festival or a new moon or sabbaths"

"sabbaths" σαββατων (Gk. sabbaton, cf. Mk. 2:27, 28; Acts 13:14; 42, 44; Acts 17:2; etc.)

2 Corinthians 3:4-17

What: *"The Ministry of death, written and engraved on stones" (v. 7; i.e., Ten Commandments, cf. Ex. 34:1, 28; Deut. 4:13; 9:9; 10:1-4)*

What Happened:


"Passing Away" (vv. 7, 11, 13)

"Is Done Away" (v. 11, KJV)

By Whom:

"Taken Away In Christ" (v. 14)

Where: *"In Christ" on the cross (Col. 2:14-16)*




The Sabbath?

What Law Is Spoken of in Romans 7:7?

*"What shall we say then? Is the law sin? Certainly not! On the contrary, I would not have known sin except through the law. For I would not have known covetousness unless the law had said, '**You shall not covet**'."*

What "law" said, "You shall not covet"?

Answer: Deut. 5:21

*"Therefore, my brethren, you also have become
dead to the law through the body of Christ, that you
may be married to another. . . . But now we have
been delivered from the law, having died to what
we were held by. . . ."*

(Rom. 7:4, 6)

The Sabbath ABOLISHED!

Ephesians 2:14, 15

"For He Himself is our peace, who has made both [Jew & Gentile, sjw] one, and has broken down the middle wall of separation, having abolished in His flesh [at the cross, sjw] the enmity, that is, the law of commandments [10 commandment covenant, sjw] contained in ordinances, so as to create in Himself one new man from the two, thus making peace."
